

All plenary sessions will be held in the Lobethal Centennial Hall in the main street of Lobethal.

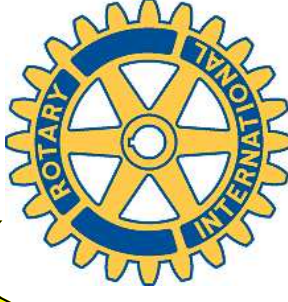
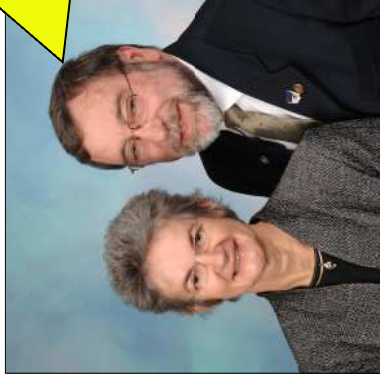
Parking is within about 3 minutes easy walk of the Hall and the House of Friendship.

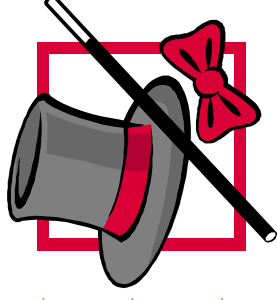
